KINGDOM OF LESOTHO TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

CATEGORY	REQUIREMENTS
Arriving travellers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Will be subjected to Public Health Screen
Passengers arriving through Moshoeshoe I International Airport	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Will fill in self-declaration formsWill be subjected to Public Health Screening
Ill travellers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">If a traveller is detected ill during screening at the point of entry (PoE), s/he will be referred to PoE clinic for secondary screening/assessment.Will be subjected to rapid antigen testing (in the case of COVID-19 suspects)In case of COVID-19 or any upper respiratory infection, the traveller will wear a mask and take all required precautions.
Seriously ill travellers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Will be referred to the hospital for further management.
Departing travellers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Will meet the requirements of the receiving countries.
Travellers departing to Malaria endemic countries	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Malaria prophylaxis orTravellers without prophylaxis will be advised on appropriate preventive measures whilst in the Malaria endemic countries.
Travellers departing to Yellow fever endemic countries.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Valid Yellow fever vaccination certificate orWill be advised on the vaccination requirements of the country of destination.

NB: As of 22 08. 2022, COVID-19 vaccination is no longer a travel requirement, however travellers can choose to get vaccinated at the PoE.
