

## **KINGDOM OF LESOTHO**

## TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

CATEGORY	REQUIREMENTS
Arriving travellers	<ul> <li>Will be subjected to Public Health Screen</li> </ul>
Passengers arriving through Moshoeshoe I International Airport	<ul> <li>Will fill in self-declaration forms</li> <li>Will be subjected to Public Health Screening</li> </ul>
III travellers	<ul> <li>If a traveller is detected ill during screening at the point of entry (PoE), s/he will be referred to PoE clinic for secondary screening/assessment.</li> <li>Will be subjected to rapid antigen testing (in the case of COVID-19 suspects)</li> <li>In case of COVID-19 or any upper respiratory infection, the traveller will wear a mask and take all required precautions.</li> </ul>
Seriously ill travellers	<ul> <li>Will be referred to the hospital for further management.</li> </ul>
Departing travellers	<ul> <li>Will meet the requirements of the receiving countries.</li> </ul>
Travellers departing to Malaria endemic countries	<ul> <li>Malaria prophylaxis or</li> <li>Travellers without prophylaxis will be advised on appropriate preventive measures whilst in the Malaria endemic countries.</li> </ul>
Travellers departing to Yellow fever endemic countries.	<ul> <li>Valid Yellow fever vaccination certificate or</li> <li>Will be advised on the vaccination requirements of the country of destination.</li> </ul>

**NB:** As of 22 08. 2022, COVID-19 vaccination is no longer a travel requirement, however travellers can choose to get vaccinated at the PoE.
